

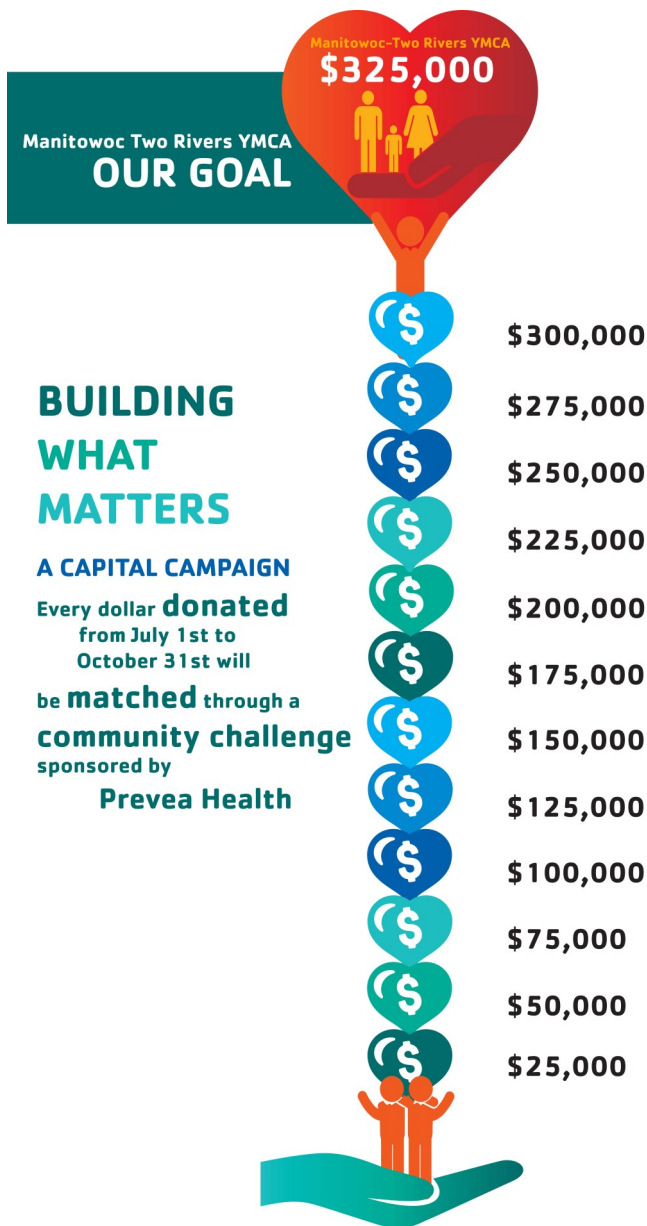

July 12th: Groundbreaking event in gymnasium 1

July 13th: Staging of equipment begins in the YMCA parking lot. The Lot will still be open for regular use. Safety fencing will be installed to protect Y users from equipment and materials.

July 17th: Demolition of the current boys and girls locker rooms will begin. During demolition and rebuilding the boys and girls locker rooms men will share their locker room with the boys and women will share their locker room with the girls. We will have Locker Room Monitors on duty in both locker rooms to ensure safety, cleanliness and assist members who may have questions.
