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We have been getting a lot of questions about the Energyze program (formally known as the Summer Teen Leaders). For the past 3 years this has been the follow up program to Y B.R.E.A.K. With the school district realigning we have also aligned our programming to reflect that. What is the ENERGYZE Program?

This is a program for 6th – 8th graders that focuses on Service Learning, Social Emotional learning, and a summer of hands on fun. This is the 4th year we have been running this program.

Where is the Energyze Program held?

The "home" base for the program is in the conference room of the YMCA; however, most days we our out in the community working on projects or visiting different areas of the city. Each day will include a free lunch at Madison School or a sack lunch.

What times is the Energyze Program held?

The program runs from 8am-3:30pm Monday – Friday. These are extended hours from the past 3 years. There is no supervised care before 8am or after 3:30pm. Your child can stay at the Y as long as they abide by the rules of the YMCA. Please have all participants here no later than 9am.

Dates of the program are: June 10th – June 28th and July 8th-Aug. 2nd. There is NO programing the week of July 1st – 5th.

Can my child do summer school and still be in the program?

At this time we will not be taking half day registration. Because of logistics of this program and how the program is structured. You may choose to do weeks that summer school is not being taken.



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How will the program run?

Each week the participants will be able to sign up for community service projects and activities that interest them. We know that this age group likes some control over what they are doing, so we like to incorporate that component. There will be guest speakers, and some programs that ALL participants will go to. There will be off site activities, field trips, lunch at Madison School, swimming and gymnastics.

Is this a licensed program?

This is a non-licensed program. Child care assistance will not be able to be used for payment.

How will I make payments?

This is considered a program and ALL fees need to be paid BEFORE the start of the week. NO EXCEPTIONS!! If payment is not made, your child will not be able to be in the program until payment is made.

Can I choose what weeks my child can be there?

Yes. You can do some or all the weeks of the program.

If I choose not to do all the weeks when do I sign up?

If you will be full time (5 days) the weeks you want your child to participate sign up is April 4th. Part time may sign up May 1st if space is available.
